Why this matters...

Chronic absence in elementary school is associated with a 7% reduced likelihood of high school graduation. Someone who drops out of high school will earn almost \$1 million less than a college graduate over a lifetime. Those who do not complete high school have significantly shorter life expectancies than those who do continue.
