## DIRECTIONS

Take NY State Thruway to exit 12; Follow signs to Route 303 North. Drive 1.7 miles north on Route 303 and make right turn into parking lot at 140 Route 303. (Across from the Foodtown Shopping Center and Valley Cottage Post Office.) Entrance is in front of building.

OR
